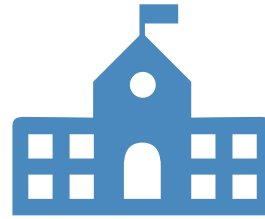
Where you're born should not result in a lower life expectancy, decreased earning potential, or ability to succeed in school, but it does in many parts of North Carolina.

81 years



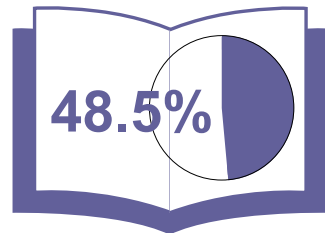
Life expectancy
