

Sample Application Questions

Q1: Tell us about your organization. What is your mission? What are you trying to accomplish overall? (This is likely more than can be achieved with a single grant.)

Q2: Please briefly describe what you are attempting to accomplish with grant funding. How will you measure progress toward this goal? (You should reference the goal listed in the funding announcement.)

[200 WORDS]

Q3: Briefly describe the work for which you seek funds. This should be a summary of how you will work toward your goal.

[500 WORDS]

Q4: What challenges do you think you will face in working toward your goal, and how will you address these problems? Obstacles could include laws or policies, the political environment, difficulty hiring in rural areas or similar barriers.

[250 WORDS]

Q5: Data show that in North Carolina, African Americans, Latinos, American Indians and those living in poverty often suffer the worst health and education outcomes. We also know that the people most impacted by poor outcomes are not always included in creating solutions to these problems. Please describe how your work will address these disparities in outcomes and decision making.

[250 WORDS]
